Pottery

For Adults

Adult pottery classes are available for beginners and intermediates. The curriculum covers hand-building, wheel-throwing, glaze application, and decorative technique on high-fired stoneware. Only pots made with clay supplied by Wesleyan Potters can be fired in our kilns. Clay and tools cost extra, but glaze materials and firing are included. Classes meet on holidays unless otherwise noted.

Jewelry

Our courses are designed to accommodate both beginners and advanced students, covering all the fundamental techniques of jewelry making, including sawing, filing, soldering, texturing, and patina coloring. An optional one hour bench time will be available for Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday morning classes for a \$5 fee.
