Pottery

Adult pottery classes are available for beginners and intermediates. The curriculum covers handbuilding, wheel throwing, glaze application, and decorative techniques on high-fired stoneware. Only pots made with clay supplied by Wesleyan Potters can be fired in our kilns. Clay and tools cost extra, but glaze materials and firing are included. Classes meet on holidays unless otherwise noted. **16 students max.**
